






Australian Equity Market Growth

Contributions to Market Growth (A\$bn)






Contribution to ASX by industry



Market Capitalisation of ASX Listed Infrastructure Funds (\$ billion)






Benchmark Index Performance CY05








Australian Market Performance

S&P/Citigroup Broad Market Index World Total Return Indices (US\$); Average Annual % Change, End-1995 to End-2005






Market Trading Volumes and Fees




