

## H M Jackson Prize

The H M Jackson Prize is awarded each year to the most outstanding paper published by, or presented to, a body other than the Institute of Actuaries of Australia.

### Eligibility

Any paper published or presented in the 2013 calendar year is eligible for the 2014 H M Jackson Prize. A nominated paper should have been published in an overseas journal; presented to an international or foreign conference; or published in or presented to an Australian non-actuarial journal or conference. In the case of published work, 'paper' can be taken as including a broadly similar item, such as a book or book chapter. Jointly authored papers are eligible, however most authors (or at least one of the authors in the case of a two-author paper) should be members of the Institute.

### Selection

The Actuaries Institute's Research Council Committee is responsible for awarding the Prize on behalf of Council. The Actuaries Institute is not obliged to award the Prize if in the opinion of the Research Committee no nominated paper warrants the Prize.

The selection criteria are:

- 1 Evidence of original thought and research on actuarial practice and theory (highest weighting).
- 2 Standard of presentation, logic and clarity.
- 3 Usefulness of the reported findings to the profession.
- 4 Interest in the reported findings to the profession generally or to particular sections of the profession.
- 5 Amount of effort evidently committed to the research.

Relatively higher credit is given to a younger and/or less experienced author, and to a piece of work that has received recognition outside the Australian profession.

A nominated paper may be non-technical or not directly associated with the profession, or may be reporting collations and correlation of data, practices, etc. However, such papers will be given a lower weighting when the nominations are being reviewed.

### Nominations

The Institute encourages nomination of papers that conform to these requirements. A paper may be nominated by any member, including the paper's author.
