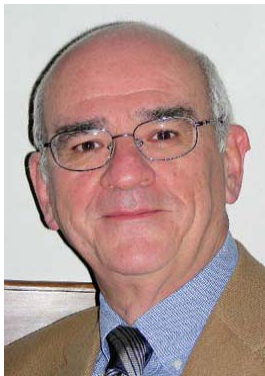

This workshop covers technical aspects of medical expense insurance including sickness, disability and long-term care, ranging from the basic actuarial structure of the insurance products to more advanced actuarial modelling issues.

Among these, the following aspects will be addressed:

- technical problems which arise when benefits are linked to an index;
- feasible premium arrangements in which the premium rate is linked to the individual claim experience; and
- the impact of (aggregate) longevity risk on the cost of the insurance cover.



Ermanno Pitacco is Professor of Actuarial Mathematics in the Faculty of Economics, University of Trieste and Academic Director of the Master in Insurance and Risk Management at the MIB School of Management of Trieste.

He is an actuary and full member of the Istituto Italiano degli Attuari (Italy), affiliate member of the Institute of Actuaries (UK) and a member of Groupe Consultatif Actuariel Européen.
