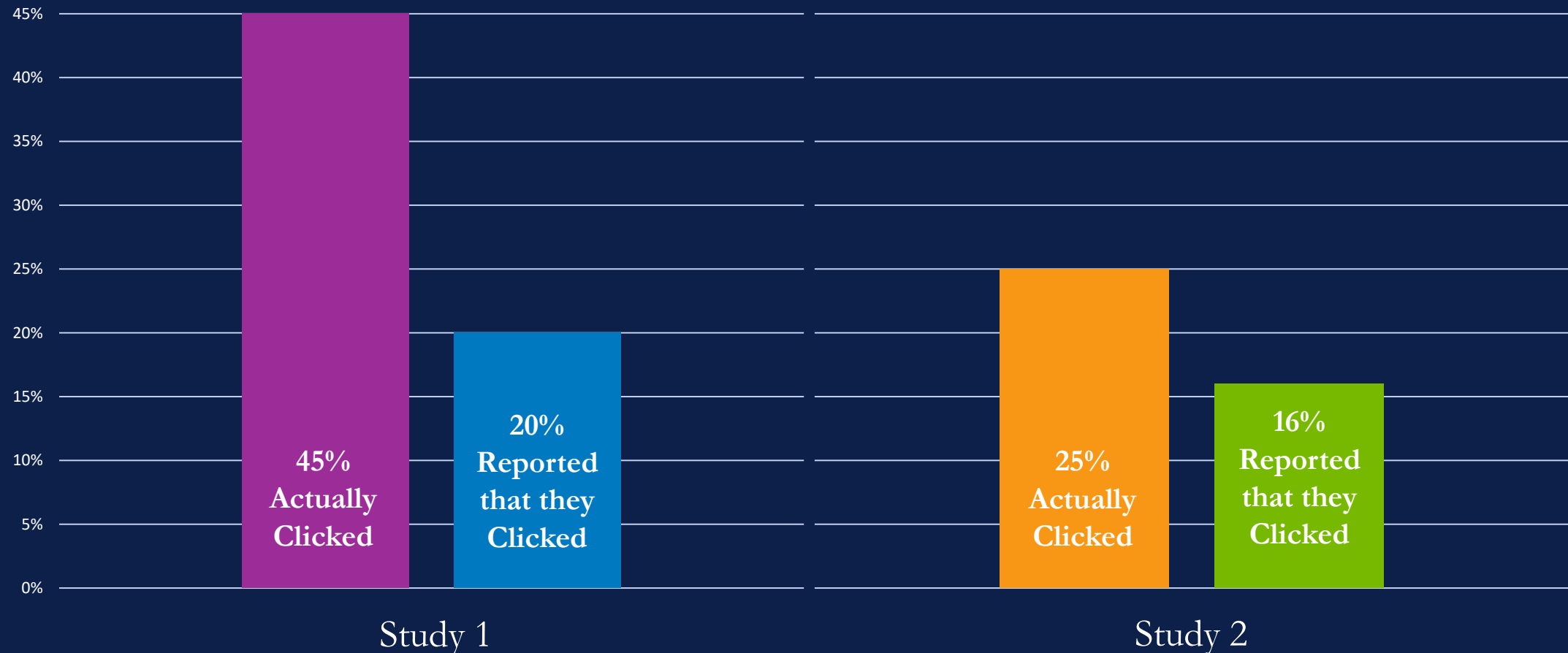

SINGAPORE SURRENDERS

Fighting Ceased at 10 P.M. Sunday

32 Fleeing Enemy Warships, Transports Destroyed By Navy

30,000-TONNER SUNK

A force of 32 enemy warships and transports, which had been ordered to leave Singapore was either sunk or destroyed by the Imperial Navy between February 13 and 15. The Imperial Navy announced at 3:30 p.m. Sunday. The announcement said:

"The Imperial Naval Fleet operating in waters near Singapore caught and attacked enemy warships and transports which had been trying to escape from Singapore in the southern part of the same island and in the neighborhood of Bangka Strait, as a result of

Leads Southern Campaign



Unconditional surrender of the British forces in Singapore was officially announced by the Imperial Headquarters at 10:10 p.m. Sunday. The communique reads: "The Army Forces operating in Malaya made the enemy in the fortress of Singapore surrender unconditionally at 7:50 p.m. on February 15."

PARACHUTE UNITS TAKE PALEMBANG AIRPORT

The surprise attack on Palembang, Sumatra, by the parachute troops of the Imperial Army on February 14 was announced in a communique issued by the Imperial Headquarters at 2:15 p.m. Sunday. The announcement reads:

"Powerful parachute units of the Imperial Army made a surprise attack on Palembang, Sumatra, the largest oil producing center of the Netherlands East Indies at 11:36 a.m. on February 14.

"After having driven away the enemy forces defending Palembang, the parachute troops occupied an airfield and other strategic points, and secured that territory."

FIGHTING CEASES AT 10 P.M. SUNDAY

Singapore

SINGAPORE, February 15.—Ceasefire of hostilities throughout the entire front in Singapore on and after 10 p.m. today was agreed as a result of a historic meeting which took place between the commanders of the Japanese and British armies in Malaya.

The momentous meeting between the Commander-in-Chief of the Japanese Forces in Malaya, Lieutenant-General Tomiyuki Yamashita, and the Commander-in-Chief of the British forces in Malaya, Lieutenant-General Robert Percival, was held from 7 p.m. today at the Ford Motor factory situated at the foot of Bukit Timah and General Percival signed the terms for unconditional surrender at 7:50 p.m. As the result of unconditional British surrender, it was decided to cease hostilities throughout the entire front in Singapore on and after 10 p.m. today.
